• Pray that in celebrating our national identity our eyes are opened ever wider to see all who have suffered, that we work together for the common good of all.



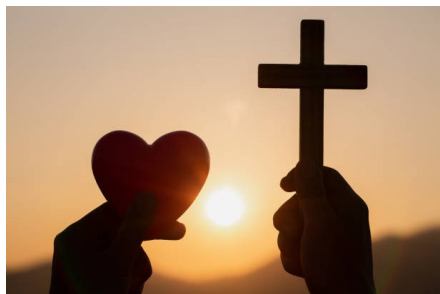

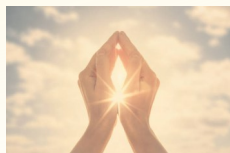
